2. Goal:

- To sensitize the students about various dimensions of gender discrimination to bring equality.
- To engage the students in activities that would empower them to work towards a gender just society.
- To Promote awareness about women's rights and gender equality through educational campaigns, workshops, and Seminars.

3. The Context:

In India, the movement of education and empowerment of weaker section including women is originated by Mahatma Jotirao Phule and Kranti Jyoti Savatribai Phule. Both of these are from Satara district. To continue this movement is our passion. As woman is considered to be inferior and secondary to man in the male dominated society, she is marginalized by society, religion and patriarchy intentionally. We are living in the Republic State, yet the situation of woman has not changed to the desired level. Though the preamble of the Indian constitution focuses on the equal treatment to men and women, the condition of women is not much different than that in the earlier days. As citizens of India it is our primary duty to uphold the values of equality, liberty, justice and fraternity enshrined in our constitution.

4. The Practice:

While going on the pathway of women empowerment, the college undertakes various activities. It conducts gender audit. We take feedback from **Principal** faculty and staff. Through this we come to know their emotional as well as other **Vidyasagar Infotech College** needs, priorities and demands. Taking all these things into consideration the institute **Jamnagar** organizes various programmes and activities such as lectures, trainings regarding their health, hygiene, self defence, skill development, awareness rallies, legal awareness campaign, etc.

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➤ **Awareness Programs**

This college is devoted to the women empowerment to bring gender equality continuously. The women's day is celebrated by inviting great revolutionary social workers to talk to the students to make them think and work for the society. The guest lectures are organized to create awareness about the laws and rights of the women. They are also given the equal opportunity in the activities like youth festival, elocution competitions, sports, military recruitment etc. Suggestion boxes are provided in the campus to collect the suggestions and complaints of the girls.

➤ **Self-defense:**

The college periodically provide self-defense training to girl students and faculties.

➤ **Skill development and Career opportunities:**


The college provides various short-term courses. Through these courses the girls are given opportunity to start their own business. The girls are also encouraged to participate in sports competitions. The college organizes zonal and inter-zonal games to offer these girls an opportunity to participate in such competitions on the home ground.

➤ **Training by GOs and NGOs, Leadership Development Programs:**

The girls are encouraged to speak in the various speech, debate, and spontaneous elocution competitions to increase their confidence, stage daring and develop leadership qualities among them. The girls participate in employment and leadership development programs organized by GOs, NGOs and University.

➤ **Catering Special Needs of Minority and Backward Caste Girls:**

This college takes the special care of marginalized girls. It provides scholarship facility to these girls as per the government rules and regulations. Apart from this, some girls do not receive the government facilities due to lack of documents. This happens because of lack of past record of girls due to migration, natural calamity and wards of the forlorn women. They are given special fee concession and brought to the mainstream of education. In some communities there is lack of awareness of education. The parents of such needy girls are given counseling so that the girls could continue their education.


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5. Evidence of Success:

As a result of the various activities organized by the college, the girls have become self-confident and are able to express their views without fear.

Due to the continuous vigilance, there is no complaint registered of sexual harassment either in campus or off the campus.

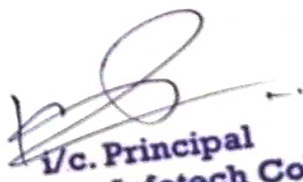
